\$10,000 REWARD

for information leading to an arrest and conviction

My mother Margaret Thornton “Peggy” Lammers was found murdered in our family home on Stove Point Tuesday, July 11, 2017. She arrived in Deltaville on the afternoon of Saturday, July 8, 2017, and her last known contact was late afternoon Monday, July 10, 2017.

It is now a year later and no arrests have been made. We, her family, know little more than we did then. As more time passes, we are losing hope that the answers we need are coming, and are begging for your help. I am desperate to know what happened to my mom, and you, the members of her community, may unknowingly hold vital information.

Anything you may have noticed, no matter how small, may hold a key to finding her killer. If you were on Stove Point, or had guests on the Point, please let us know. If you saw her in town during last summer, we want to hear from you. Or, for her Cleveland and Richmond community, if you spoke with her at all during this time, we are asking that you contact us.

The Middlesex County Sheriff’s Office has emphasized that what seems trivial to you may be of great importance.
