Dual Party Primary Election

Tuesday, August 4, 2026

POLLS OPEN 6 a.m. – 7 p.m.

July 24, 2026	Deadline to apply for a ballot to be mailed to you. Request must be received by local voter registration office by 5:00 p.m.
July 24, 2026	Deadline to register to vote or update an existing registration. Voter registration applications must be postmarked on or before the deadline.
August 1, 2026	Last day to vote early in person at the Election’s Office.
August 4, 2026	Vote in-person at your local polling place from 6 a.m. – 7 p.m.
<i>Election Day</i>	Mailed ballots must be post marked by 8/4/2026. Ballots returned in person must be received by the Election’s Office by 7:00 p.m. All ballots placed in the drop boxes must be dropped in by 7:00 p.m. on 8/4/2026.
Ballot Drop off Location	A ballot drop box is located at the Election’s Office. This box is available during business hours of the Election’s Office.

Register to Vote

The Constitution of Virginia requires that voters be registered in the precinct in which they live in order to be qualified to vote. Any qualified resident of Virginia may apply for voter registration or update his or her registration information by completing, signing, and submitting a voter registration application. Citizens can register to vote and check their voter registration information at www.vote.virginia.gov

You may apply to register to vote by mail by completing and returning a voter registration application form in the manner and time provided by law. Applications are available at the Voter Registration office, your local post office, Urbanna town office, and the public libraries.

July 19th and July 26th from 11:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

All County Offices will be closed on Independence Day (Observed) July 3, 2026.
